- Inventory and requisition supplies, repair parts, and equipment
- Work through procurement channels using AF Form 9 and other methods to procure and maintain agreed upon stock of supplies and equipment
- Receipt, accountability, and inventory of electronic equipment and components
- Data entry to query and enter information for supply, acquisition, and inventory purposes
- Pull and stage equipment for shipment to various sites
- Package equipment for shipment and prepare the necessary paperwork
- Staging and shipping equipment for repair and maintain records of account for items shipped and transported (database & paperwork)
