 - Lightning protection and supporting ground and power connections
 - Cabinets, cable ladder and rack systems, and equipment components in the cabinet
- Pass a pre-deployment screening
- Complete a military Combat Readiness Center (CRC) process

Role and Responsibilities:

- Drawings shall reflect engineered solutions be of sufficient detail to serve as installation drawings
- Convert the mark-up drawings to final, as-built drawings
- All drawings shall be completed in AutoCAD to comply with Building Industry Consulting Service International (BICSI) and USAF standards
